

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
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
TURNING WOMBS INTO TOMBS



All of us believe in human rights, don't we? Who gets human rights? Well, if women get women's rights and children get children's rights then humans get human rights. So when do humans begin their lives? Science has taught us that beings which reproduce sexually begin their lives at fertilisation or conception. And from the moment of fertilisation the one celled embryo is alive and growing rapidly into two cells and then four and so on. We know that the embryo is human because the parents are human. This human embryo matures into a human foetus and then a human baby and then a human adult. The terms embryo, foetus, baby, toddler, teenager and adult are simply indicators of growth as a human being.

Every abortion kills a human being. Any abortionist will tell you that an abortion can be considered successful only once the child's heart has stopped beating. The proabortion lobby often uses terms that are misleading. Try speaking against abortion and the first response you'd hear is 'my body, my choice' or the terms 'women's rights' or 'reproductive justice' or 'clump of cells'. None of these terms explain what an abortion truly does - abortion is the intentional killing of the child in the womb either by starvation or by crushing the baby's skull or by tearing the child apart limb by limb. India permits abortions all the way upto 24 weeks including chemical





abortions and surgical D&E abortions. Here's what happens in first and second trimester abortions.

The abortion industry never shows us the victims either but the truth is that each "choice" has a face. Earlier this year, pro-life activists obtained a box of 'waste' that came out of an abortion clinic in Washington DC. In that waste, the activists found the bodies of 115 babies of which 5 were nearly full term babies. A Catholic priest buried the bodies of these babies of various ages and arranged a proper funeral for them. The five nearly full term babies were named and they are Christopher X, Harriet, Phoenix, Holly and Angel. The Supreme Court of the United States of America recently overturned *Roe v Wade*, a move that is a huge win for life. For decades American pro-life activists, bishops, priests, religious, youth and medical professionals have struggled to end the horrific slaughter of unborn in their country. As St Mother Teresa says, "We must not be surprised when we hear of murders, of killings, of war, of hatred. If a mother can kill her own child, what is left but for us to kill each other?" India has a long way to go in safeguarding and upholding the dignity of every human life.

India kills 15.6 million babies every single year through abortion. That number itself is too high to comprehend but that's not all. Induced abortion is not the only way children are killed. IVF and certain 'contraceptives' also kill babies. There are contraceptives that work both as abortifacients and contraceptives. The pill, morning after pill and Copper-T all serve as abortifacients in the way that if they fail to prevent conception, these methods induce miscarriages in the woman's body to expel the child and thereby cause an abortion. In such scenarios the women don't even know that they are pregnant and that their "contraceptive" just killed their baby.

In Vitro Fertilisation (IVF)

The Catholic Church understands that couples who struggle to conceive suffer greatly. She therefore encourages research and the use of various medical techniques aimed at reducing human sterility as long as the methods used fully respect the dignity of the human person. In vitro fertilisation (IVF) involves the process by which the father's sperm and mother's egg are fertilised in a glass dish and the embryos are later transferred into the mother's womb. This process of artificial fertilisation is one of the methods which the Catholic Church considers to be morally unacceptable. Here are 7 reasons why:


- Catholic teaching maintains that every child has the right to be conceived in the natural marital embrace or sexual act of the husband and wife.
- 2. The human sexual act has two components unitive and procreative. IVF separates these two and makes the procreative component its only goal .Through IVF the child is no longer the result of the physical and spiritual union of the married couple.
- 3. IVF makes the child a commodity produced in a laboratory and makes doctors technicians and even business people part of the conception process.
- 4. The sperm used is usually obtained by









The abortionist forcefully pulls to tear off the limbs one by one, dismembering the living child.

masturbation which the Church teaches is immoral since the deliberate use of the sexual faculty for whatever reason outside of the marital embrace is essentially contrary to its purpose.

- 5. If one of the spouses is infertile it may be necessary to use sperm or eggs which are donated from a third person. This method infringes a child's right to be born and raised by his or her biological father and mother who are bound to each other by marriage and to know their parents. It is also a betrayal of the spouses' fidelity to each other.
- 6. Many if not most of the conceived embryos who should be respected as new and unique human lives end up dying, being discarded, frozen indefinitely or even used for research. Others after being transferred into the womb may be removed and left to die by a process called selective reduction. Those who do survive have a greater chance of birth defects.
- 7. Children are a gift from God and not a right to be obtained. Though the desire to have children is a noble one, the child's rights must be safeguarded these include

- a. the right to be the fruit of the physical union of his or her biological parents and to be raised by them
- b. the right to be respected as a person from the moment of conception and not to be treated as a commodity or manipulated.

In light of the gospel of Jesus Christ while sterility may present a married couple with a great trial it still allows for hope. Spouses who remain infertile after trying all the morally legitimate medical procedures such as NaPro Technology should unite themselves with the Lord's cross, the source of all spiritual fruitfulness and life. They can express their generosity by adopting children or giving their lives in service for others.

Now you'd ask 'What about parents who have already conceived children through IVF?' The Catholic Church extends the grace of God's mercy by calling them to repentance and the sacrament of confession. She nonetheless sees each of these children

as a gift from God no less than any other regardless of how they came into the world.

Conclusion

Marriage and the family is under attack through abortion, IVF, contraception and the LGBTQ ideology. Sr Lucia, one of three visionaries of Fatima said, "The final battle between Our Lord and Satan will be about marriage and the family. And those who work for the sanctity of marriage and the family will experience persecution and tribulation because this is the decisive issue. But do not be afraid, for Our Lady has crushed its head." As the battle between the culture of life and the culture of death wages around us, let us turn to Our Lady, Queen of Families. May the Mother of Life intercede for our nation and obtain for India the grace to accept the Gospel of Life and the courage to bear witness to it resolutely, in order to build, together with all people of good will, the civilisation of truth and love, to the praise and glory of God, the Creator and lover of life.

HOW THE "HANDMAID" OF THE LORD ATTAINED TRUE FREEDOM

"Man is called to freedom. Freedom consists not in doing what we like, but in having the right to do what we ought." - St. John Paul II

This quote is another example of the great symbiotic union of a great philosopher and a greater theologian in the person of St. John Paul II. As a thinker, he was deeply fascinated by the freedom that every human innately possesses. On the other hand, he deeply knew and loved the teachings of the Church about the redemptive mysteries of the Messiah, culminating in His perfect sacrifice on the cross. He was also a great follower of the virtuous examples of the saints and, above all, of the Queen Virgin herself, who enjoyed the absolute freedom of Christ's love.

In Mary is manifested the fullness of freedom. She is the ideal Christian. For a Christian, the ultimate form of freedom comes when our actions are directed purely and unapologetically by God's will. Today, most of us look at freedom as liberation from all kinds of physical, emotional, and moral baggage. We do not want our emotions, beliefs, and morals to dictate the outcomes of the claims that we make. It is an attempt to be truly free and unique and one with a different outcome than the outcomes of those choices that were made before that moment. But, often in an attempt to be

free in all possible ways, we have taught ourselves to be free from goodness itself. Our freedom is no longer a tool used for the good of the other.

This behaviour is also backed by a feeling that stems from the thought that true freedom can only be achieved when one can make free decisions without being compliant with the possible physical or emotional setbacks that can be caused by the outcome of the decision. But just like any other thing in this world, freedom, too, comes at a price. The outcome of the choices you make and the impact they have on your life and the lives of the ones they are directed towards, and the ripples that they make in society, are the price of your freedom to make that choice. Hence, freedom becomes a double-edged sword, capable of harming the hands that wield it.

Thus, we cannot pretend to keep morality away from freedom, for freedom will always have moral implications. This also makes it extremely important to understand that being free and having freedom are two different checkpoints in the same circuit. So, we need to understand Mary's greatness through the salvific outcomes of her choices, as well as the depth of her freedom when she surrendered her entire life into His hands.

Just the way Christ's Kingship and His Cross stand as a stumbling block to the Jews and foolishness to the Gentiles (1 Cor 1: 23), so is Mary's womanhood a stumbling block and foolishness to this generation filled with men who use contraceptives, women who abort, and teens who

fornicate. Her virginity, motherhood, and chastity are a symbol of contradiction for all those of this world 'who claim to be wise, but have become fools.' (Romans 1:22)

In contrast to the freedom to kill or die, Mary rose to God by exercising her freedom to live. Mary's yes to God has two key aspects , which is important when considering the freedom she was bejewelled with.

1. Mary's yes to Jesus Christ, who is God: In the last few centuries, especially the second half of the 20th century and the 1st half of the 21st century, the human race has struggled to say yes to God. For we are enslaved by the limits of human rationale, held captive by every uncertainty to which the human mind has no answer. But through faith, comes enlightenment that is unknown to minds that have only traversed along the path of reason. Thus, as fragile and insignificant as we are when all by ourselves, our limitations hold us captive, which can be broken through faith and God's light. Mary's yes to the Divine Child made her the 'Mother of the Living', for through her, you and I have been saved by the Messiah.

2. Mary's yes to Jesus Christ, the man:

The culture of death, which was thought by many as a thing made up by puritans of the Church, is visible in plain sight in today's world more than ever before. This culture of belittling the worth of human life is nothing but a vicious basilisk that started its existence by feeding upon the seeds and pods of promiscuity and impurity, and later attained maturity when it crept in through the walls of conjugal love and destroyed it from within by the sins of contraception and fornication, and finally inserting its poisonous fangs into the fruits of love, killing millions of unborn children every year through the gore act of abortion. Just as a mother is always connected to her child, Mary is always connected to Jesus. When Christ suffered and died on the cross at Calvary, Mary

suffered and died with Him. For when the child dies, the mother dies too. This is why many women who have had an abortion in the past are still struggling to forgive themselves for doing so, because deep down they know that that unborn baby was as much a human as any other person. Unlike other acts of murder, two people die in an abortion; the child dies a physical death, but the mother experiences an internal death. This freedom is contrary to the freedom to kill, and to make decisions without thinking about consequences, but yet be subjected to the doom that is brought about by these very consequences. Mary's freedom is hard to sell in the world, for it encourages us to look beyond the world.

Thus, Mary's strength comes from her perfect surrender to God. As the Queen of Heaven and Earth, she now assists us in breaking free from the most difficult chains of sin, particularly those of the flesh, and allowing us to freely cast ourselves upon the flower bed of Divine Providence. The peace one attains when "that void" in the heart, "that ache" that cannot be explained, is filled with heaven's love, rather than with pleasures that could never calm the soul, that only delights in the love of its Creator.

Are You A Victim To The Ongoing Spiritual Epidemic?



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Years ago, when I happened to see an image of Christ crucified, I thought; thought of the ugliness and utter humiliation that a Man had to go through. And for what? For me, you and our unpleasant choices. The image that I was exposed to was the expression of the 'greatest love'. (John 15:13)

That brings us to the question. What is love? Love is simply wanting the best - Heaven for each and every person around us. Contrary to popular

belief, the Church is an extremely loving community and encourages its expression, especially through the conjugal act between the husband and the wife. Let's just state it. Sexual desire is good and the Church couldn't agree more. You can only corrupt something that's already beautiful. And the marital union between spouses has become prey to this tragic process. The beast here is pornography, which harms relationships, reduces intimacy, rewires the brain, and leads to unwanted health consequences. Yet, 1 in 8 searches on the internet is for erotic content. The problem with pornography is not that it shows too much but too little of the human person. Instead of valuing people as children of God, they become mere objects of selfish gratification. There is nothing empowering, cool, free or fun about enjoying seeing naked people.

The saddest part of the world we live in is ignorance toward sin. Gone are the days wrong



was considered wrong. The nature of sexual sins is such that it can be easily justified as a prop for 'education', 'love', and 'self-care'. When these words are used in any argument, bargaining becomes a doddle and consequent actions become 'natural'. Threats to Chastity like pornography and masturbation hide behind this mask of 'pseudo support.' This deceit blinds us to see its darker side that aids in monetizing an industry of sexual predators. The direct relationship between porn demand and the trafficking demand is glaringly obvious and statistically accurate. Thus, through every lens pornography has NO gains.

Something that inevitably follows porn consumption is the mortal sin of masturbation. Today, this isn't a taboo topic, but a matter of celebration for the majority of the secular crowd. Martin Seligman, author of 'Authentic happiness' says that true happiness is rooted in becoming intimate and engaged with others. By contrast, the more self-involved you are, the shallower, and ultimately the less happy you become. The problem of masturbation is, it takes the whole purpose and meaning of sexual union, which is 'we' and makes it about 'me'. After years of research, we can confidently state: a) Masturbation does not have the same effects as sexual union, b) There are NO negative health effects of NOT masturbating and c) Masturbation can be shown to cause negative health effects. Whether you keep religion out of it or not, masturbation has NO positive on the well-being of an individual. Now having known that pornography and masturbation are evidently detrimental, spiritually and socially, having a laissez-faire approach to them is purely diabolic.

If the price of our sins had to be paid in terms of the faculties used in order to commit that act (Rev. 18:6), it's just fitting that the price of our salvation, too, would be paid likewise. Thus, Christ crucified, and suffered in every way possible - agony, betrayal, loneliness, and especially, humiliation when He was stripped of His garments and raised as a criminal for no crime of His own. Peter Kreeft, Christian

philosopher, says, "In the next life, time as we know it is no more. You can't change your fundamental character anymore. The time to change is now." We are meant for greater and eternal relationships with actual human beings and with our Divine Father Who Lives. Swapping the act of true love and selflessness, for a few moments with a lifeless screen and a box of tissues to gratify a fleeting desire is simply a foolish move

But what is your alternative? Choose Chastity!

God created man in His own image and likeness. (Gen 1:26). While He created all other creatures great and small with just His word, He chose to personally form us-Body, Mind, and Soul; loved us so much that He sent His only beloved Son into this world to redeem us (John 3:16). Hence I am, you are, we are all precious and honored in the sight of God and He chooses to dwell within us (1 Cor 3:16). We are, thus, anointed to glorify Him in our body, mind, and soul. We are called to adhere to the virtues of purity, chastity, and holiness that must form the crux of our lives and our journey to eternal life. We are all fragile beings. Often we may succumb to the flesh and lustful gratifications of the world. This is when we are called to exercise one of the most beautiful gifts of the Holy Spirit i.e. Self-Control to practice Chastity.

Chastity means the successful integration of sexuality within the person and thus the inner unity of man in his bodily and spiritual being (CCC 2337).

For a deeper understanding, let's study chastity through these three classifications:

Body: We already know that our body is a gift from God and we are called to maintain the sanctity of our body as well as the body of another individual. Jesus asserts that when we look at a person with lust, we have already committed adultery. Our eye is the lamp of the body. When we keep our eyes and our body away from the lustful sights of the world by



exercising self-control, which is when we are truly able to keep ourselves from lustful desires (porn & masturbation).

Mind: We are called to exercise self-control in our thoughts and desires. For we are only tempted in the areas of what we desire; desire leads to sin and sin leads us to eternal damnation (James 1:14-15). What we see, speak, hear and feel is stowed in our minds and thoughts. If our minds are held captive in the lustful inclinations of the world, it would reflect in our actions thereby causing us to sin. (Sexual fantasies, porn & masturbation)

Soul: Jesus died so that our souls may unite with Him. We will only gain true satisfaction when our souls rest in God (St. Augustine). But when we sin against our flesh; against the sanctity of our bodies, we hurt this very Holy Spirit and thus cause ourselves to invalidate the presence of the Holy Spirit from our lives-leading to the ultimate downfall of the glorious life Jesus purchased for us, by His blood, to be destroyed. (Romans 8)

So, is practicing Chastity rocket science? NO

Is it difficult? NO

What chastity requires is persistence!

David defeated his giant - Goliath with just 5 stones in his hand. So can you defeat your giants! Here are your five stones:

- 1. Holy Eucharist (Spend time with Jesus)
- 2. Sacrament of Confession (Spiritual diaper change)
- 3. CLING to Mother Mary (Mother of God and Serpent slayer!)
- 4. Intimate whisperings with the Holy Spirit.
- 5. FLEE from situations that lead you to sin and surround yourself with accountable people.

The crux of the Christian life is taking up your cross with Christ. If purity is something you genuinely struggle with, know that God has destined greatness for you in overcoming your temptations. The Catholic Church has remarkable saints to look up to for purity and above all, we have its epitome as our very own mother, the Immaculata! But even with similar levels of perversion and deterioration in their times, we're awaiting a saint from the recent years who battled temptations in the saga of extremely accessible pornography. Could that be you?

And as you wait - be steadfast. When things get difficult - pray. When you are tempted - hold on stronger; for, with Christ, NOTHING is IMPOSSIBLE! (Phil 4:13)

The Culture Of Death In India



Introduction

Abortion and contraceptives are closely connected to the control of the population all over the world, and India is no exception. The Supreme Court of the US in 1973 permitted abortions (Roe vs. Wade judgment) across the country. However, two years before the US Supreme Court judgment; in India, women's right to seek an abortion was established by the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971.

Indian Population

About 50 years ago, with the notion that abortion could be a mode of population control, the Government of India considered a law to "decriminalize" induced abortion. In 1964, the

Central Family Planning Board formed a committee to examine the subject of abortion. Ironically, the Abortion Study Committee was headed by the health minister of Maharashtra. Many of this committee's suggestions were included in the subsequent MTP Act of 1971. With the President's nod, the MTP became an Act on August 10, 1971.

On the fiftieth anniversary of the old MTP Act, the new MTP Amendment Act 2021 was signed. This amendment increased the threshold for abortions from 20 to 24 weeks. This new amendment, furthermore, permits the gruesome termination of innocent babies, for an unrestricted period in the event of foetal abnormalities.



The UN report, released last week, says by 2050, India's population will reach 166. 8 crore, surpassing China's population of 131.7 crore. The findings of the report have sparked a debate in many quarters over whether India needs to act more on its population policy programmes. The UN report on population has rekindled the debate on the population bill. The panic is so unfounded, that according to the latest National Family Health Survey (NFHS), the Total Fertility Rate (TFR) is decreasing in India, and it has gone down from 3.4 in 1992-93 to 2.0 in 2019-21.

The Societal Impact

Over the last 50 years, fertility rates have dropped drastically around the world. In 1952, the average global family had five children—now, they have fewer than three. Lower fertility rates, coupled with increased life expectancies around the world, are creating an ageing population. An older population comes with several economic risks, including rising healthcare costs and a smaller global workforce.

China's one-child policy of 1979 was aimed at slashing the nation's population to boost economic growth. It resulted in millions of forced sterilizations, abortions, infanticides, and marital misery. As sons were generally preferred over daughters, the overall sex ratio in China became skewed toward males. In 2016, there were 33.59 million more men than women. Even after the one-child policy was rescinded, China's birth and fertility rates remained low, leaving the country with a population that was ageing too rapidly as well as a shrinking workforce.

In India, with the rise of contraceptives and abortion, the number of children available for adoption has drastically reduced. The statistics with the national adoption agency, CARA, state that while some 28,000 prospective parents have registered to adopt, less than a tenth of the number of children — 2,200 are legally free for adoption.

The Catholic Church

In his first Apostolic Exhortation—Evangelii



Gaudium # 213—Pope Francis warns that "efforts are made to deny the unborn their human dignity and to do with them whatever one pleases, taking their lives and passing laws preventing anyone from standing in the way."

St. John Paul II in his encyclical Evangelium Vitae #20, laments that "To claim the right to abortion, and to recognise that right in law, means to attribute to human freedom a perverse and evil significance: that of an absolute power over others and against others."

Indian Church

Last year, the Catholic Bishops of India, invited all of us to observe August 10th, 2021 as a "Day of Mourning" in India, so that through various means the Holy Church can express her sorrow at the killing of pre-born babies in the womb and promote a "Culture of Life" in our families.

This year, the National Catholic Charismatic Team has organised the first 'National March for Life' in the national capital. This march will be attended by various Bishops, priests, Religious Sisters, and a large laity. This march will be held every year on the 10th of August to commemorate the brutal killings of the unborn.

Conclusion

It is estimated that about 15.6 million unborn children are butchered at various government-approved abattoirs in India. With the new MTP Act of 2021, we find ourselves deeper in a dramatic conflict between the "culture of death" and the "culture of life". We need to offer up prayers and sacrifices as reparations for the many transgressions of the murder of pre-born babies and become passionate ambassadors for the Gospel of Life.

process that included numerous setbacks. Nevertheless, after knowing the dark side of it, you can never look at it the same way again and continue with it. And, that's where I realised a couple of things, which knowingly or unknowingly helped me overcome it. The importance of personal prayers and how people pray for you matters, especially when you're trying to come out of sin. And most importantly, realising the power of Confession and the Holy Eucharist, which gives you the grace to tackle temptations.

And let's not forget, "God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear." (1 Cor. 10:13) I will never say that it was a cakewalk, but now I can keep my hand over my heart and say, "I DO NOT watch porn anymore and I've overcome it!"

My name is Arlene Theknath, and I am blessed with three children and an awesome husband who has brought out the best in me. Together with a team of like-minded people, we at "The Saved Pearl Foundation" help women in crisis pregnancies and protect the lives of unborn children.

It sounds like a picture-perfect story, right? Well, that was not the case twenty years ago.

Growing up, my dad was my role model, but he was a strict disciplinarian. And due to this, there was an emptiness, a void that I carried within me, which I thought would be complete when I fell in love with my boyfriend, who is now my husband. I thought he could fill in that space and so I gave myself away in mind, in heart and, unfortunately, in body.

It was in the month of April that my world fell apart. I was pregnant and unmarried. I remembered the parable of the prodigal son. I felt he was justified, but

it was only after the fall that I related to the shame, guilt, and loneliness of the prodigal son. I decided to go ahead with the pregnancy, but the fear of the unknown, the labels that society would attach to me, was something that I did not want to face. Just like the prodigal son, I decided to submit my situation to the Heavenly Father. The song that I would keep singing was God will make a way, and yes, He did make a way. I got married in the month of August. I still remember the day I gave birth. My husband carried our daughter and kissed her. This picture has ever since been treasured in my heart.

"The Saved Pearl Foundation" became a reality because of my husband's support and encouragement. Through this initiative, we were able to save the precious lives of twenty-two unborn babies. We have had a sixteen-year-old pregnant girl come to us; we have had rape victims; unwed pregnant mothers, pregnant women abandoned by their families; pregnant women beaten up by spouses and thrown on the streets come to us; and trust me, I can relate to their pain, their suffering, their shame because I have gone through it all. Our experiences can turn us bitter, but when placed at the feet of Jesus, he can turn it around. I still face challenges which make me concerned about the future, but I trust the loving hands that hold my future.

What entailed me to receive God's message of love and freedom



I am a beloved son of God. I am passionately Catholic. I also experience same-sex attraction. I first realised my attraction towards other men sometime in my early adolescence. For years, I intentionally ignored and hid my sexuality out of fear, isolating myself in shame and developing a growing resentment toward God and the Catholic Church. I repressed the attractions I experienced, inevitably causing me to cave in on myself. After an extended period of time spent in suppression and self-wallowing, I decided to begin acting on my same-sex attractions and embrace life outside of the Catholic Church.

I romantically and sexually pursued other men. I attended gay bars downtown and became heavily involved in local LGBT+ social circles. Throughout my late teen years and into my early adulthood, I lived a life that the world promised would be "liberating" and "freeing." Though temporarily satisfying, however, it was a life that ultimately left my soul unfulfilled. No matter what man I was involved with or what party I was crashing with my friends, my soul was always craving something and someone far greater. Though I wouldn't have admitted it at the time, I knew deep within myself that Jesus was the only One who could ever fulfil the many unmet longings of my heart.

It wasn't until the Lord woke me one night with a dream, a dream that truly shook me at my core, that I began to seriously discern a relationship with Jesus Christ. Since the night he gave me that dream almost four years ago, I have slowly but surely pursued a life that looks radically different from before. I still experience same-sex attractions, though I now strive to live chastely according to Catholic Church teachings on homosexuality. I maintain a holy community of fellow Christ-followers who hold me accountable and love me in the ways I need to be loved. I no longer identify myself strictly by my LGBT+ experience since who I am at the core of my personhood is so much more than my sexuality. First and foremost, I live out of my place as His beloved. Through

living out of my belovedness, I can wholeheartedly confess that I have never been more at peace and more alive than I am now. Amidst all my brokenness, I belong to the Catholic Church. Amidst my messy past, the Lord is making a new and vibrant creation out of me. What a beautiful cross this is. What a wonderful God He is!

How I perceive the church's teachings on homosexuality

For the longest time, I perceived the Catholic Church's teachings on homosexuality and chastity as being mundane, unfair, and bigoted. I didn't understand why the Church refused to bless same-sex relationships, nor was I interested in understanding Her reasons behind such a refusal.

It wasn't until I started intentionally pursuing a relationship with the Lord that I began intentionally seeking out His truth. It wasn't until I intentionally sought His truth that I started to understand the context for why the Church teaches what She teaches about homosexuality and I began to receive it in its whole goodness.

The Catholic Church isn't aiming to "restrict" Her members who have LGBT+ experiences from happiness and freedom. On the contrary, through Her teachings on chastity, the Catholic Church is the only institution in the world that actually invites people who have LGBTQ experiences into authentic freedom and true joy.

I am fully aware that it's such a countercultural concept, but it's a sacred reality that I can personally attest to. Are the Church's teachings on chastity difficult to embrace at times? Of course, they are. Dying to self is never "easy" because "easy" never needs Jesus to begin with. Without a doubt, I admit that the cross is heavy. Whether it be an LGBT+ experience or something else, a cross wouldn't be a cross without its heaviness and tribulation.

With this said, however, I cannot emphasise enough the great joy I have found in embracing the various crosses in my life. Through the cross awaits a glorious Resurrection. The world lacks in comparison to the Resurrection that Jesus has in store for each of us! To sum things up: in Church teachings lives the Spirit of Christ. Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom (2 Corinthians 3:17).

t. Maximilian Kolbe was a prisoner at Auschwitz when three prisoners escaped from the camp. The Nazi soldiers decided to starve a group of ten men to death as a 'lesson' to the others. When one of the selected men cried out that he had a wife and children. St. Kolbe volunteered to take his place to save the life of a stranger. Likewise, St. Gianna Molla was an Italian mother who refused an operation to remove her cancerous womb to save her unborn child. Instead, she chose to give her life to save the life of her daughter, whom she loved so dearly. Closer home in India, about 15 to 20 priests, including a Bishop and a nun have donated their kidneys to the poor out of love for that person.



What is Love, anyway?

The world describes that love is involuntary. Brain science tells us it's a drive like thirst. It's a craving for a specific person. Love, like thirst, will make you do strange things. It's normal, natural to "lose control". Therefore, they say that one "falls in love". As the world portrays, is it a sexual desire for someone? Feeling all fluttery inside when they walk into the room? Wanting to spend most of the time or maybe the whole day together? St. John Paul II argues in his book 'Love and Responsibility' that although all of these things can exist in a loving relationship, they're not love in themselves. Love is not just a feeling or desire, but an action. Love is a verb: the act of doing what is best for the one you love, even if it means sacrificing yourself, just as Christ died for every one of us. St. Thomas Aguinas says - To Love is to will the good of the other. Romantic relationships should not be any different.

Is sex dirty?

The Catholic Church's teachings on sexual morality are one of the most misunderstood among the young. Many say that "the Catholic Church hates sex." One of the complaints against Catholicism is that - it is a religion of 'NO', especially in the area of sexuality. When the rest of the culture is moving in a much more progressive direction in this regard, the Catholic Church seems to be a kind of 'old fashioned' or 'bronze-age' religion. Is sex so dirty and sinful that God wants us to avoid it at all costs? In an age when non-marital sex is slowly spreading its tentacles around our generation, one may wonder if the traditional teaching of the Church is totally outdated and unrealistic. But it is better to clear up some of those misconceptions.

Why so many rules?

When you tell someone that the Catholic Church doesn't hate sex, and that it says that sex is a good thing, the first thing they usually argue is, "Then why so many rules about sex?" The Church does have rules about sex, but they're not indications of any negative opinion of sex. Another area in which the Church has a lot of rules is the

Eucharist: You must be a Catholic to receive it, you can't be in a state of mortal sin, and you've got to fast for at least an hour before receiving it. These rules are because it's beautiful and sacred and must be respected, at all costs. We feel in awe at how important the Eucharist must be, how highly God must think of it, and the same goes for sex. And that's a good reason why sex is considered so beautiful and sacred.

What does the Church teach?

The Catholic Church teaches that sexual love between a man and a woman is reserved only for the Sacrament of Matrimony. We find this teaching in the creation account of Genesis — First, God creates man in His own image and likeness, making them male and female (1:27). In the next verse, the Bible reads, "God blessed them, saying, 'Be fertile and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it.'" Before the man and woman come together as husband and wife, and before they express their love as husband and wife, they are first blessed by God. Only in marriage do we find God's blessing upon the act of marital love.

Body - the Temple of the Holy Spirit

In the Sacred Scriptures, St. Paul exhorts us to "Shun fornication! Every sin that a person commits is outside the body; but the fornicator sins against the body itself. Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you were bought with a price; therefore, glorify God in your body. (1 Cor. 6:18-20) And again, in the same letter St. Paul warns "If anyone destroys God's temple, God will destroy that person. For God's temple is holy, and you are that temple" (3:17)

Hence, true love will avoid the other person committing mortal sin. Sexual union is a gift from God and, like any gift, can be used for good or bad. It is meant to be beautiful and sacred between a man and wife – in the context of marriage. A life of sin would be a horrible preparation for the Holy Sacrament of marriage.

Heavenly Banquet

Before receiving the Sacred Blood the celebrant gives thanks to the Lord for His ineffable love in these words 'you prepared the cup of your most Precious Blood for the guest at your banquet. You allowed me, sinful as I am to partake of that cup". This prayer reminds us that Eucharist is the foretaste of the heavenly banquet and that it is in this heavenly banquet that we partake through Holy Communion (Mt. 8:11). Hence Jesus is called the heavenly bridegroom (Mt. 9:15, 25:1, 5, 6, 10). Jesus loves the church as the bride and nourishes her through His Body and Blood. Here everything is mentioned in relation to Christ: 'Your banquet', 'Your most precious Blood', 'You prepared', 'You allowed' and 'Your ineffable love'. All these we receive in the divine gift of Eucharist.

May the Grace be made perfect

This is followed by the rite of distribution of Holy Communion. Before distributing the Holy Communion the celebrant blesses the community saying "May the grace of Our Lord Jesus Christ... be made perfect in us through His mercy". This prayer reminds us that it is through the Eucharistic Communion that the grace of Our Lord is made perfect in us and that it is effected through the mercy of Christ. The community responding "Always and for ever Amen" express their desire to be always filled with the gift of the grace of our Lord. The aim of Eucharistic sacrifice is reconciliation and communion with God. This is achieved through the Holy Communion (CCC. 1382). Through the Eucharistic Communion we are coming into union of love with God and with one another.

Church Invites you

The blessing of the celebrant is followed by the prayer of invitation of the deacon. This is called 'Onitha d' Vathe' or 'hymn that follows'. Variable forms of this prayer according to the liturgical season is given in the propria.

Through this prayer the deacon, in the name of the Church, is inviting the whole community for holy communion. Just as Jesus on the shore of Tibeias, after having prepared bread and the fishes, invited His desciples saying 'come and have breakfast' (Jn. 21:11) here the church is inviting her children to share in the divine banquet prepared by the Lord (CCC. 1384).

With Faith in the Heavenly Kingdom

This prayer 'Onitha d' bathe' for ordinary days is: "Brothers and Sisters, the holy Church invites you to receive the Body and Blood of the Son of God with faith in the heavenly kingdom". It is the Eucharist that enkindles in us hope in the heavenly kingdom. This prayer reminds us that we should receive the Holy Communion with the faith that one day we will be able to participate in the heavenly banquet. Here we should have in mind these words 'Happy are those who are invited to the wedding feast of the Lamb' (Rev. 19:9). These words 'with faith in the heavenly Kingdom' expresses, our faith and strong hope that one day we too will be invited for the heavenly banquet.

Receive the Body and Blood of the Son

All those who receive the invitation of Church our Mother come forward to receive Holy Communion. It is to receive the Body and Blood of Christ that the Church invites her children. Our participation in the Holy Qurbana becomes complete only with the reception of Holy Communion. Whenever possible we should receive Jesus in this sacrament of God's love.

KNOW YOUR FAITH

Is the Bible pro-abortion? Did God allow the Israelites to have abortions in the Old Testament?

The Gospel is innately pro-life and pro-eternal life. In Genesis, after Cain murders Abel, God tells Cain that Abel's blood cries from the ground to Him. In the 10 commandments given to the Israelites through Moses, God makes it very clear that every murder is evil in the eyes of the Lord. Numbers 5:11-31 mentions the ordeal of bitter water, which is claimed by many people today as a passage supporting abortion, but this is false, as it is a Hebrew ritual to find out if a woman has committed adultery, who is made to drink bitter water (a little mud added to the water, which is clearly not an abortifacient), and it literally says that if her thigh does not waste away and if her abdomen does not swell (in other words, if she is

able to conceive after the ordeal), then she is not guilty. The husband could not do anything in this entire process, and the intention behind ordeals was to put everything into God's hands,



and these were performed in the presence of the priest. The passage does not presuppose that the woman is pregnant, thus the argument that it encourages abortion is clearly baseless.

What does the Church teach on homosexuality?

The Church's teaching on homosexuality can be found in the Catechism of the Catholic Church: #2357: Homosexuality refers to relations between men or between women who experience an exclusive or predominant sexual attraction toward persons of the same sex. It has taken a great variety of forms through the centuries and in different cultures. Its psychological genesis remains largely unexplained. Basing itself on Sacred Scripture, which presents homosexual acts as acts of grave depravity, [Cf. Gen 19:1-29; Rom 1:24-27; 1 Tim 1:10] tradition has always declared that "homosexual acts are intrinsically disordered." [CDF document 'Persona Humana' #8] They are contrary to the natural law. They close the sexual act to the gift of life. They do not proceed from a genuine affective and sexual complementarity. Under no circumstances can they be approved. #2358: The number of men and women who have

deep-seated homosexual tendencies is not negligible. This inclination, which is objectively disordered, constitutes for most of them a trial. They must be accepted with respect, compassion, and sensitivity. Every sign of unjust discrimination in their regard should be avoided. These persons are called to fulfil God's will in their lives and, if they are Christians, to unite to the sacrifice of the Lord's Cross the difficulties they may encounter from their condition.

#2359: Homosexual persons are called to chastity. By the virtues of self-mastery that teach them inner freedom, at times by the support of disinterested friendship, by prayer and sacramental grace, they can and should gradually and resolutely approach Christian perfection.

We are not just pro-life but pro-eternal life. St Thomas knew that Jesus is the ____ and the (John 11:25).


